
#### **B&G COMMITTEE UPDATE to Board 09/26/2024**

- Following the 2017 Hurricane Irma, we planted a number of new trees on Master
  Association Grounds. These trees have now grown considerably, so we will be doing
  more pruning than normally would be the case over the coming months. We will seek
  Board approval if trimming will exceed budget.
- Tree Trimming remains underway.
  - The fenceline along the lake at Harrington Sound required substantial trimming to remove exotics. (see photo) Fence repairs will be assessed once complete
  - The fenceline buffer along our south entry of Windstar Blvd was over trimmed.
     This was an error but the vegetation will benefit from a denser regrowth beneath the existing canopy of palms and Black Olive trees.
- We received draft project plans from two firms for the redesign of the "Marina" entrance off Hamilton Avenue. ALD has completed a conceptual design. Our initial reaction is that their proposed design meets our driving objectives of:
  - enhanced security, and
  - a look that is consistent with that of Windstar's Main Entrance on Bayshore Boulevard.
- ALD has been requested to work up pricing associated with the conceptual design and this will be submitted to the Board with a recommendation after reviewed at our committee meeting next week.
  - Please review the concepts attached to this report. The preferred option is
     Option A, with tree type/ placement from Option B
- Several annual beds have been replaced with perennial color to help maintain the visual appeal while overcoming the iguana damage that was happening when we planted annuals in these locations.
- Security plantings were completed at both the Marina gate (bougainvillea) and near Regatta (green buttonwood) to make known trespass locations more difficult to get through.
- Weeping Podocarpus trees over our entry walls are mostly doing well but there are 3
  or 4 trees that have died off and have been removed. The Committee will assess need
  to add trees.
- Median beds continue to be a struggle. Plumbago doesn't do well in wet season and Ixora hasn't bloomed much for months. We added some nutrients to Ixora for better greening and are allowing them to grow a bit more. We intend to see how they react to more nutrients (fertilization allowed again in October) into the end of the year but we may need to consider alternatives down our most visible interior through way. The Plumbago beds have been replaced with American Agave, as the Agave is not susceptible to the high alkaline issues plaguing the flowering plants and they also coordinate better with our front entry wall design. All planter areas are to receive sleeves for irrigation and landscape lighting.

Sleeve sizes are to be 2 sizes larger than actual pipe size.

Landscape Lighting

It is anticipated that Landscape lighting will be installed.

All grades Represent Finished Grades
Unless Otherwise Noted (ie. 'Slab')

Contractor to verify property lines and setbacks before construction.

Contractor must have property lines staked and located, and must verify plan dimensions and field conditions are consistent.

Any Inconsistencies w/ these plans need to be reported to ALD and the Owner.

Contractor shall verify that he has the most up to date plans, and that they have been approved and accepted by the Owner before commencing construction.



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

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

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

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
